



# 2021 YEAR 12 STUDENT PORTAL

## Keep track of important information in Year 12

The student portal displays personal information that relates to your Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE), Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement (WASSA) and other senior secondary school achievements. Click on the relevant section to view your enrolments, results, achievements, examination timetable/s and key dates to keep you on track in Year 12.

### Visit the student portal to:

- ❑ check your personal details
- ❑ check your enrolments
- ❑ complete your *Student Declaration and Permission* (Year 12 students, and anyone enrolled in a Year 12 Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) course, should do this by Thursday, 17 June 2021)
- ❑ complete your Year 12 ATAR English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) eligibility application by Friday, 26 February 2021
- ❑ download a copy of your *Personalised written examination timetable* if you are enrolled in a Year 12 ATAR course from Thursday, 9 September 2021
- ❑ download a copy of your *Personalised practical examination timetable* if you are enrolled in a Year 12 ATAR course with a practical component from Thursday, 9 September 2021
- ❑ download a copy of your *Physical Education Studies practical examination information* – sport to be examined and skill level
- ❑ download a copy of your approved special examination arrangements
- ❑ download a copy of your sickness/misadventure outcome
- ❑ check your results on Monday, 20 December 2021
- ❑ view and download digital copies of your WACE, WASSA, ATAR course reports, ATAR examination results, and any awards from mid-January 2022. You can present these digital certificates when applying for university, TAFE, employment or training.

### Login instructions

- Click on the link to the student portal: <https://studentportal.scsa.wa.edu.au>.
- Your password has been set to **Nnddmmyyyy**, where **Nn** is the first two letters of your family name, the first as a capital letter (A–Z) and the second as lower case (a–z), followed by **ddmmyyyy**, which is your date of birth in day month year format.
- When you log in to the student portal for the first time, you will be prompted to change your password.
