

## **Explanation of changes to the 2022 Activities Schedule**

- references to March and September rounds of OLNA changed to Round 1 (March) and Round 2 (September) respectively.
- the delivery of ESTs by schools has been scheduled for Weeks 2, 3 and 4 in Term 2 (as was previously the case before 2021).

Tuesday, 17 May ◆  Due date for receipt by the Authority  • Applications to sit ATAR course examinations outside of Western Australia.	This activity was moved from Term 3 to Term 2 due to the organisation required to establish examination centres.
Monday, 13 June ♠  Available to schools/providers and students in Student Record Management System (SRMS) via the student portal  ● Online applications for permission to enrol in a WACE language course in 2023 for study of Second, Background and First Language courses in any of the following languages: Chinese, French, German, Hindi, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean or Tamil.	Applications are now carried out online via the Student Record Management System rather than the hard copy form.
Thursday, 11 August ◆  Final date for upload into SIRS  • Enrolments in single Year 11 units for Semester 2 for Year 11 students (via ENCOS file). Note: after this date, this SIRS facility will be locked and no further changes (except withdrawals from these courses) will be accepted.	New entry.

Thursday, 8 September ◆  Last date for receipt by the Authority  Online completion of all Year 12 student declaration and permission details (relating to the release of personal information, use of school work and examination responses).  Note:  schools should advise students that if they do not complete this by Thursday, 15 September, all of their answers will revert to 'no'. If the student is subsequently an award recipient in December, their name will not be published.	Note has been included to advise students of the consequences of not completing the declaration and permission details by the last date.
Friday, 16 September ▲  Available on the website  • Sickness/misadventure application form for ATAR course examination candidates.	New entry.
Wednesday, 12 October ▲  Start of student interviews for the School Curriculum and Standards Authority's 2022 VET Awards.	Later start date than in previous years.
