EXTERNALLY SET TASKS FOR YEAR 12 GENERAL AND FOUNDATION COURSES 2016

I write to you in regard to students enrolled in a General Year 12 course and/or a Foundation Year 12 course in 2016 who are required to complete the Externally Set Task/s (EST) developed by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (the Authority).

ESTs are to be administered by schools during Term 2, 2016 and are based on identified Unit 3 syllabus content. The identified content on which each EST is based is available on the course page of the Authority's website. Please note that the EST content for the final 10 courses will be released at the beginning of October 2015. The final 10 courses are highlighted in the list of General and Foundation courses attached.

It is imperative that all teachers who will be teaching Year 12 General and Foundation courses in 2016 are provided with the EST content sheets and that they have taught this content before Week 4, Term 2, 2016.
