



Completing the *Application for permission to enrol in a WACE language course*

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- 1) Indicate for which language you wish to apply
- 2) Provide your 8 digit SCSA Student Identification Number or check with your school

Section 1 The following information needs to be provided:

- (a) Your family name or surname as registered with the Authority
- (b) Your first name and second name
- (c) Your date of birth
- (d) Your gender
- (e) Your country or place of birth
- (f) Your arrival date in Australia and age on arrival if born overseas
- (g) Information about being enrolled or intending to enrol in English as an Additional Language or Dialect

Section 2 This section is to be completed by the school

- (a) Name of the school and school code
- (b) Language teacher's name or school contact person for enquiries
- (c) Email of teacher or school contact and their telephone number

Section 3 This section consists of 3 parts:

1) Information about your education

You must complete all parts of the table in 3.1.1 with the names of schools you attended (when and where) and indicate the language of school instruction as well as any previous instruction in the language. This information needs to be provided from 5 years of age until the present.

If you attended any community or ethnic schools, complete all parts of the table in 3.1.2 with the names of the schools you attended (when and where). Indicate the language of school instruction and number of hours of instruction per week.

2) Information about your residency

You must complete all parts of the table in 3.2.1 with the names of the country(-ies) you resided in (even if you only lived in Australia) and when. Passport pages and an *International Movement Records* document must be provided as evidence of residency in or travel to countries where the language is spoken.

3) Information about the language(s) spoken at home and outside the classroom

You must provide information about the language you first learnt to speak and the language(s) you speak at home and outside school.

If there is any other relevant information that will support your application please use the space in 3.4 to provide this.

Section 4 This section provides a checklist to ensure you are submitting all the documentation that is required

Section 5 This section contains the Statutory declarations to be completed by you and your parents, the teacher endorsement and the Principal's declaration.

All these must be completed and signed by the relevant persons. Your teacher cannot act as an authorised witness and sign the statutory declaration.
